Purpose:

1. Commitment to Academic Excellence

Understand and respect academic requirements, including Chinese language learning and maintaining minimum grade thresholds.

2. Upholding Behavioural and Ethical Standards

Support the scholar's efforts to uphold high academic standards and good moral character.

Understand and respect academic requirements, including Chinese language learning and maintaining minimum grade thresholds.

3. Health, Safety, and Well-Being

Provide full, honest disclosure of any medical, mental health, learning, or dental needs.

Comply with all health and safety requirements, including medical check-ups and vaccinations.





Maintain valid insurance and be prepared to handle emergencies, including traveling to China if repatriation is not possible.

4. Cultural Adaptation and Community Integration

Encourage the scholar to respect and engage with local culture, traditions, and norms.

Support the scholar's Mandarin language acquisition (HSK or A-Level Chinese).

5. Financial Transparency and Planning

Disclose accurate financial backgrounds for scholarship determination.

Cover any costs not included in the scholarship and be prepared for additional expenses related to undisclosed citizenship or travel complications.

6. Communication and Collaboration

Maintain open, respectful communication with the school and scholarship administrators.

Provide accurate and current contact information.

Participate in required orientation sessions and ensure the scholar does as well.

7. Authority and Finality of School Decisions

Acknowledge that the school's decisions while the scholar is in China are final and binding.

Agree not to contest these decisions during the scholarship period.

8. Agreement and Accountability

Understand that non-compliance or non-disclosure may lead to disciplinary action, including the withdrawal of the scholarship.

Parents accept responsibility for any additional costs arising from non-disclosure of citizenship ties, medical issues, or other relevant factors.
